



Repeat Dispensing Made Simple!

What is the repeat dispensing scheme?

It's simply a way to get your regular monthly medicine more easily.

What do I need to do to apply for this?

Contact the surgery and ask for a form to apply for repeat dispensing, complete it and hand it back.

What happens then?

1. The surgery sends your pharmacy 6 months worth of prescriptions.
2. When you need your next lot of medicine, phone your pharmacy to let them know you will be collecting it.
3. Your pharmacy will get your medicine ready for you to collect, or will deliver it to you if you ask them to.
4. When your pharmacy run out of your prescriptions they will tell you to order some more from the surgery.
5. You must then request another 6 months of prescriptions from the surgery in writing and the process starts again at number.1

In summary by being on the scheme you only need to order a new batch of prescriptions from the surgery when the pharmacy tells you to and in between just let the pharmacy know when to have your medicine ready to collect.
